Job Description

They are responsible for the oversight of all water and aquatic program activities. They also work with the Land Activities Director and Leadership Team to plan and implement all camp-wide activities and evening programs. You will become a role model to dozens of children each week, as well as lead and support the counselors.

- Supervisory or leadership experience
- Lifeguard and paddlesport experience
- Must have a sincere desire to work with children
- Computer skills, including Excel and Word
- Current Lifeguard certification preferred
- Good moral character

- Assist in the facilitation of summer overnight camp according to YMCA and ACA standards.
- Provide quality programming and progressive skill development for campers
- Supervise and manage all aquatic activities and program staff
- Help Village Directors with weekly schedules and program staffing
- Supervise, coach, and support summer camp staff
- Ensure that all activities are fun, challenging, and safe for all campers
- Teach camp programs as necessary
- Keep inventory system of all waterfront supplies
- Evaluate camp program and provide input to Executive Camp Director
- Responsible for camper/cabin life issues such as homesickness and behavior issues
- Assist counselors in designing camp activities and rainy day activities
- Report all policy concerns and violations to the Executive Camp Director
- Assist with staff training
- Interpret safety and health rules, as well as other camp policies to campers and staff
- Maintain camper and staff discipline as necessary, in an appropriate manner
- Offer enthusiasm for camp life and programs, and act as role model for all

- Interpret and ensure the implementation of YMCA Character Development in all aspects of program for campers and staff
- Other duties as assigned to ensure a safe, smooth running Camp operation
